CONTENT GUIDELINES

- 1. <u>Introduction</u>. These content guidelines are an integral part of the Terms. By any use of the Platform and in particular by uploading user content, you expressly agree to comply with the following guidelines.
- 2. <u>Content guidelines</u>. You may not upload or otherwise distribute content to or through the Platform that is unlawful, infringes the rights of third parties, or violates the Terms. In particular, you may not:
 - a) distribute content that could be considered unsolicited, inappropriate, or harassing advertising, in particular your will not offer services that are unrelated to the purpose of the Platform,
 - b) distribute content that violates intellectual property rights, personality rights, disrespects dignity or creates a sense of danger (for example, language that threatens, intimidates, excludes, or silences someone),
 - c) disclose anyone's residential address, date of birth or other personal information, except for contact details such as telephone number and email address, which may only be provided in the space designated for it,
 - d) distribute content that contains any material that is defamatory, obscene, indecent, abusive, offensive, harassing, violent, hateful, inflammatory, or otherwise objectionable,
 - e) distribute content that promotes sexually explicit or pornographic material, violence, or discrimination based on race, sex, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation, or age,
 - f) distribute content that infringes any patent, trademark, trade secret, copyright, or other intellectual property or other rights of any other person.
 - g) distribute content that violates the legal rights (including the rights of publicity and privacy) of others or contain any material that could give rise to any civil or criminal liability under applicable laws or regulations or that otherwise may be in conflict with these Terms and law,
 - h) distribute content that is likely to deceive any person,
 - i) distribute content that promotes any illegal activity, or advocate, promote, or assist any unlawful act,
 - j) distribute content that causes annoyance, inconvenience, or needless anxiety or be likely to upset, embarrass, alarm, or annoy any other person,
 - k) distribute content that impersonates any person, or misrepresent your identity or affiliation with any person or organization.
 - distribute content that involves commercial activities or sales, such as contests, sweepstakes, and other sales promotions, barter, or advertising,
 - m) distribute content that gives the impression that they emanate from or are endorsed by us or any other person or entity, if this is not the case,

- n) distribute content for which you cannot provide licences in extent granted under the Terms,
- o) distribute content which is in any other way in breach of the Terms or applicable law.
